Learn How to Save a Life....and Earn CEUs in the Process

Many course takers—such as nurses, social workers, recreation professionals, teachers and day care providers—are professionals who need continuing education units (CEUs) to maintain a license and/or certification. In order to provide this added service to our customers, the American Red Cross has been approved as an Authorized Provider by the International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET). First Aid/CPR/AED Courses for Union County Businesses Provided by the Union County Chapter of the American Red Cross 2010 Course List

A variety of course combinations are available that provide the training that you need in first aid; adult, child and infant CPR; and adult and child AED. All of our courses reflect the latest science for first aid, CPR and emergency cardiovascular care and meet OSHA Guidelines for First Aid, combining lecture, interactive video demonstrations and hands-on training to teach participants lifesaving skills. Course participants also receive useful take-home materials that help retain skills and serve as an excellent refresher and reference tool after training is complete.

Standard First Aid with CPR/AED—Adult

Our most comprehensive training course for lay responders, this session provides training in first aid, adult CPR and AED skills.

Length: 6-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$560.00 plus \$70.00 for each student in excess of eight.

Standard First Aid with CPR—Adult

This course provides first aid and adult CPR training and explains the role of AEDs in emergency cardiac care.

Length: 5-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$520.00 plus \$65.00 for each student in excess of eight.

Adult CPR

For individuals who need adult CPR training only, this hands-on skills training prepares students to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies in adults.

Length: 3-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$360.00 plus \$45.00 for each student in excess of eight.

CPR/AED—Adult

Participants learn adult CPR and AED skills to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies.

Length: 4-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$400.00 plus \$50.00 for each student in excess of eight.

CPR—Child and Infant

Designed for childcare providers, teachers, parents and others who care for children, this course teaches participants how to recognize and care for breathing and cardiac emergencies in infants and children up to 12 years old. Optional child AED training is also available.

Length: 4-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$400.00 plus \$50.00 for each student in excess of eight.

CPR—Infant (applies to infants up to 12 months of age)

Length: 3 hours.

Course Fee: \$320.00 plus \$40.00 for each student in excess of eight.

CPR—Child (applies to children between the ages of 1 and 12)

Length: 3-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$320.00 plus \$40.00 for each student in excess of eight.

First Aid

Participants learn first aid skills for treating a variety of injuries and sudden illnesses.

Length: 3-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$280.00 plus \$35.00 for each student in excess of eight.

Sport Safety Training

Developed with the U.S. Olympic Committee, this course features demonstrations and lectures that teach sports related first aid and injury prevention skills. Topics include specific responses for breathing and cardiac emergencies; soft tissue and skeletal injuries; and sudden illnesses. Optional child CPR training is also available. A participant handbook builds comprehension and serves as an excellent reference for coaches, athletic trainers and anyone else who works with athletes.

Length: 6-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$560.00 plus \$70.00 for each student in excess of eight.

CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer

This course combines a participant's manual, lectures and video with hands-on skills training to cover the following areas:

- Responding to breathing and cardiac emergencies in adults, children and infants
- Using an AED on adult and child victims of cardiac arrest
- Using personal protective equipment to stop bloodborne pathogens and other diseases from spreading

Participants will receive the CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and Healthcare Provider certificate with a validity period of two years. Lifeguards participating in this course will receive the CPR/AED for Lifeguards certificate valid for one year.

Length: 8 hours.

Course Fee: \$680.00 plus \$85.00 for each student in excess of eight.

First Aid and Preparedness

Streamlined to fit into busy schedules, this interactive presentation is ideal for anyone who wants to learn lifesaving skills, but does not need certification to meet a job requirement or OSHA regulations. This information-packed session helps you stay prepared with valuable lifesaving skills and information. Topics include:

- The 3 Emergency Action Steps
 - Get a Kit
 - Make a Plan
 - Be Informed
 - First aid basics, such as bleeding, shock, burns and the warning signs of heart attack, stroke and cardiac arrest
- Participants receive unique, high-quality training materials that offer step-by-step instructions for responding to a variety of first aid and disaster-related emergencies.

Length: 90 minutes.

Course Fee: \$100.00 plus \$5.00 for each student in excess of eight.

Administering Emergency Oxygen

Laypersons and professional rescuers learn when and how to use supplemental oxygen and breathing devices. Participants receive take-home skill sheets. Adult CPR certification is a pre-requisite for this course.

Length: 2-1/2 hours.

Course Fee: \$120.00 plus \$15.00 for each student in excess of eight.

Bloodborne Pathogens Training: Preventing Disease Transmission

This two-hour training module is designed for individuals who, while on the job, may be exposed to blood or other body fluids that could cause infection. Includes participant's manual.

Length: 2 hours.

Course Fee: \$120.00 plus \$15.00 for each student in excess of eight.

Epinephrine Auto-Injector Training Module

This module can be added to first aid and CPR training and is designed to help individuals learn how to correctly administer an epinephrine auto-injector to a person who is suffering from a severe allergic reaction.

Length: 1 hour.

Course Fee: \$120.00 plus \$15.00 for each student in excess of eight.

Asthma Inhaler Training Lesson

This lesson can be added to first aid and CPR training and is designed to help individuals learn how to correctly administer an asthma inhaler to a person who is having an asthma attack.

Length: 45 minutes.

Course Fee: \$120.00 plus \$15.00 for each student in excess of eight.
