A Hometown Heroes Breakfast will be held on August 28th from 7:30 to 9:30am in conjunction with the first annual Safe and Sound scheduled from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Bunsold Middle School, 14198 St. Rt. 4, Marysville, Ohio.
